### **Formula for Calculation Acceptance/Rejection Rates**

The rejection rate is calculated as the reverse of the acceptance rate. The acceptance rate is essentially the number of acceptances divided by the number of new manuscripts received for a calendar year of manuscript processing. We adjust the number of manuscripts received to account for those “pending.” Pending manuscripts are those on which there is no decision by the end of the calendar year.

Calculate rejection rate according to the following formula.

100% – % accepted = Rejection Rate

$$\% \text{ accepted for the time period} = \frac{\text{No. mss accepted}}{\text{No. new mss} + (\text{No. pending})}$$

Example calculation of a rejection rate:

Total new MSs rec'd (March, 2018 to September 30, 2018): 94

Accepted MSs (as of September 30, 2018): 12

Pending MSs: 27

$$\% \text{ accepted} = \frac{12 \text{ MSs accepted}}{94 \text{ (new mss)} + 27 \text{ (pending)}} = 12/121 = .099173554$$

Rejection Rate Calculation: 100 - % accepted = 100 – 9.9

**Rejection Rate: 90.1%**
